The name "Kaapzicht" (Cape View) comes from the fantastic view this winery has over Cape Town and Table Mountain. Since the first vintage was bottled in 1984, Kaapzicht has become highly respected for both quality and value, having earned a multitude of local and international awards.

The Steytler Family has been running their 190 hectare large estate hands-on for three generations: Brothers Danie and George are winemaker and viticulturist, respectively, and their wives are in charge of marketing and finances, as well hiring out a venue and a self-catering cottage. Son, Danie Junior, assumed responsibilities as winemaker in 2009 as the family tradition lives on.

WINE MAKING NOTES

The grapes were hand harvested from unirrigated vineyards ranging between 5 and 25-years-old. Fermentation in stainless steel tanks for 5-7 days (varietal dependent). After very gentle pressing. The wine is transferred to stainless steel tanks for malo-lactic conversion. After completion, the wine is racked, stabilized and transferred to 225l and 300l French and Hungarian oak barrels for 16 to 18 months (varietal dependent). The wine is blended after ageing and stored in concrete tanks until bottling.

TASTING NOTES

This stylish and powerful red blend has notes of dark berries and cherries. The palate boasts richness, concentration and dense fruit.

Slow cooked beef brisket, burgers with sharp cheddar.
